### **Workshop on Native Cultural Values in the forests of eastern Ontario**

The Eastern Ontario Model Forest in partnership with South Nation Conservation and the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources is offering a 2 day workshop on Native Cultural Values in the forests of eastern Ontario.
