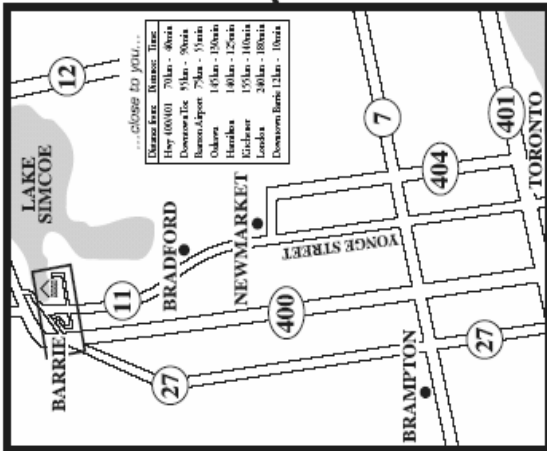
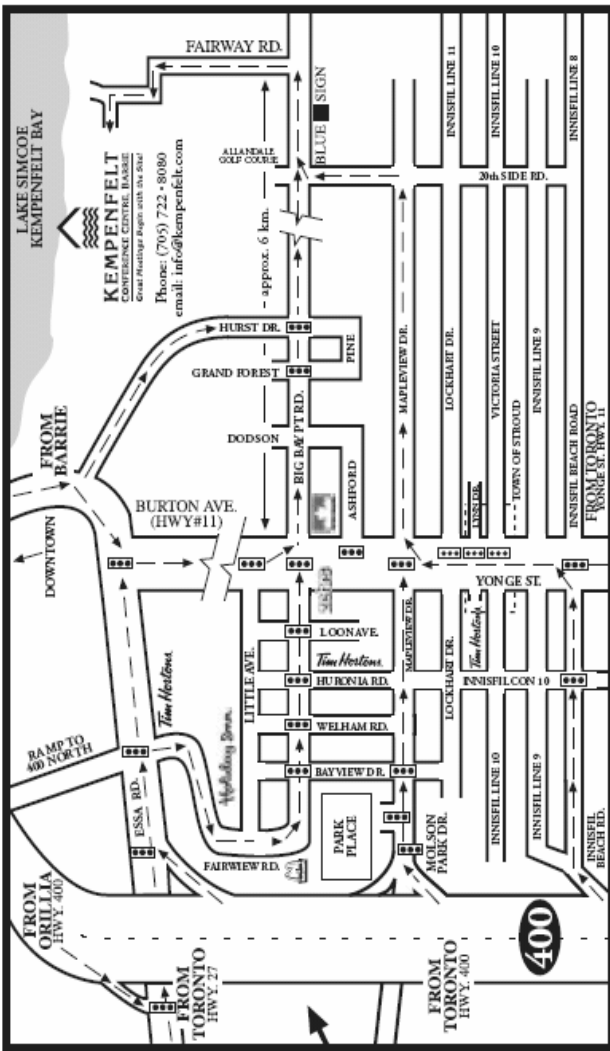


## Location Maps
